Dufferin Mine

The Dufferin Mine is a high-grade narrow vein underground gold mine located 10 km north of Port Dufferin, Nova Scotia situated along the eastern shore approximately 150 km from the city of Halifax. Planned start-up is scheduled for late March / first week of April, 2017 with subsequent expansion anticipated.

About the role

Maritime Dufferin Gold Corp is seeking highly motivated and experience underground miners with emphasis on narrow vein mechanized and non- mechanized environments. Working on a 14 day on / 14 off rotations, this role reporting to the Mine Superintendent will be responsible for leading crew in all facets of underground operations of assigned mining areas. This leadership role must also ensure all crew members participate, practice and follow all Maritime Dufferin Gold safety policies and procedures, be able to motivate, mentor, and participate in the crew success while meeting set targets. This is an excellent potential opportunity for career growth into Shifter / Mine Captain roles.
